Respected Sir/Madam,

Reference captioned subject and Hqrs Web upload dt 04.01.2024, please find enclosed latest OM No. F.4/1/2023-PPD dt 17.02.2025 (copy enclosed) issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India regarding relaxation for procurement of certain items through Global Tender Enquiry (GTE) wherein latest exemptions/relaxation are now available for 354 Medical Devices (Annexure-A) **till 31.03.2027 or till further orders.**

It is further informed that procurement is a dynamic process and there may be instances where local manufacturers may become available for certain equipment/items in the exempted list. **Accordingly, procuring entities are advised to ensure due diligence to Make in India guidelines in all cases of procurement of equipment without relying solely on the enclosed list.**

Additionally, it is reiterated that it is the sole responsibility of the Head of the Institution to ensure that Procurement done by respective user units should strictly adhere to ESIC Equipment norms, Delegation of Powers, ESIC Medical Equipment Manual and mandatory adherence to all statutory procurement guidelines (GeM/GFR/CVC/MII) while ensuring generic specifications, budgetary provisions, availability of infrastructure, manpower, approval for starting the services issued from ESIC Hqrs along with local financial concurrence such that in no case an equipment remains unutilized after procurement.

This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
